In the last above reference on deteriorating relationship, it is not surprising to learn that the mainstream media have a lot to answer for. War is good business for the military industrial complex, and they exert their influence in US foreign policy and filtered down to fellow travellers in Oz.

A war in EU or Middle East is far enough to worry ASEAN countries but a war in Asia Pacific is another matter for Australians and our Asian neighbours in particular ASEAN.

We have experienced a war in Asia involving Chinese troops as in the Korean War in 1950s. We have witnessed the resolve of the PLA despite their lack of firepower. advanced weapons and air cover to have resisted the combined forces of US and Allies.

In the Vietnam war, China was quietly aiding the North Vietnamese in materials and strategic support to defeat US and Allies.

If a war is ignited between US and Allies against China, the scenario would be very different compared to 50 more years ago.

1. China is a nuclear state
2. Chinese forces are now modernized with advanced military hardware (land, sea and air)
3. China will defend her territory integrity and the majority of 1.4 billion Chinese will be behind it.
4. The territories of US and Allies including Australia will be targeted with no exception if the war is started by US. China has openly stated this time and time again,
5. China does not want a war in Asia as it will disrupt their economy and peace - a threat to their national interests of co-prosperity and peace but will defend herself against all aggression and invasion.
6. US sanctions on China will not work as Asian countries would ignore US unilateral sanctions. Apart from Japan and Australia, no other nations in Asia Pacific including India, are willing to join in war against China but Russia will come to China's aid if need be.

A human catastrophic disaster bigger than any world war will happen to the destruction of our humanity and planet if nuclear war occurred by accident. In the end, Australia and Australians will suffer most and end up the lonely island in the Asian sphere.

The above consequences is not in our national interests and we must make our voice heard before they fire the first shot and MAD follows.
